A reliable loading bay solution designed for a level access application, with optional flexibility to accommodate double deck vehicles, standard UK vehicles, container vehicles or even vans

Features

Not all warehouses provide the required nominal height difference between the inside floor level and the external yard level to facilitate a traditional loading bay.

When faced with this dilemma, the Model ARMD modular dock system provides a very cost-effective solution that eliminates the need for major alterations and extensive civil work.

The system can be designed to suit existing level access door openings or we can form new openings in the building façade to suit.

The ARMD modular dock system is made from hot-rolled steelwork. It has a 8mm anti-slip chequer plate top deck surface supported by steelwork designed to suit the quoted load capacity.

This structure is supported by evenly-distributed robust support legs with base plates that are secured down to a suitable concrete base using anchor bolts.

To prevent any fall-off hazard from the modular dock, 1100mm high hand railing, with a central knee bar and bottom kick plate, is fitted to all exposed sides.

A modular dock pedestrian access staircase, with hand railing and a landing area, is usually included.

The ARMD modular dock is a bespoke solution. It can be built to any size and is designed to suit each customer's specific requirements.

Options

- Moving product on and off the modular dock can be achieved via pallet safety gates, an access ramp or a goods lift.
- Diagonal thrust beams can be positioned behind the buffers for when the modular dock is free-standing and not positioned against a solid structure.
- The modular dock usually incorporates electro-hydraulic dock levellers – either the Model ARSL or Model ARTL.
- Systems can be designed for hand pallet truck loading and fork lift truck loading, and for pallet storage with capacities exceeding 20,000kg.
- Access protection can be provided by sheeting the modular dock on all exposed sides.
- Available in a range of RAL colours, or in hot-dipped galvanised steel where maximum corrosion protection is needed.
